Conditions of Entry Youth Arts Scholarship Award 2019

1. Applicants must be 18 years or under on the 9 March 2019 (born on or after 9/3/2000).
2. Applicants to be residents of Bass Coast Shire or students attending schools in the Bass Coast Shire.
3. Entry form to be completed in MS WORD format and emailed before closing date to info@rotaryPISR.org.au. No other format will be accepted.
4. Closing date for entry: 5pm on **Friday 1 March 2019**.
5. Two statements to be submitted with entry.
 - a. A statement describing the work and the process or inspiration in creating it.
 - b. A statement outlining the applicant's aspirations.
6. One 2D work in any medium to be submitted for judging.
7. Work must be the original and sole creation of the applicant.
8. Work to have maximum dimension of 120cm x 120cm including frame, if any.
9. Work must be suitably mounted or framed and fitted with a secure device for hanging. Stretched canvases are considered framed.
10. Work must be clearly marked on the back of the exhibit with Rotary Youth Arts Award, title, name of artist, and address.
11. Work will be accepted for judging at the San Remo Recreation Centre, Wynne Road, San Remo (follow signs) from **10am to 6pm on Wednesday 6 March, 2019**.
12. All works will be seen by the judge/s. If there is insufficient space available to display all entries, the Judge/s may, in their sole discretion, decide which entries to display.
13. The decision of the Judge/s will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
14. The winner of the Rotary Youth Arts Award will be announced at the Rotary Club of Phillip Island and San Remo Art Show Opening evening on Friday 8 March 2017.
15. The Rotary Club of Phillip Island and San Remo will take every care of exhibits, but will not accept any responsibility for the loss of, or damage to any exhibit whilst in transit, on display, in storage or otherwise.
16. The Artist permits the Rotary Club of Phillip Island and San Remo to reproduce images of the works for publicity purposes.
17. Applicants are encouraged to enter additional art works in the Phillip Island and San Remo Rotary Art Show using the standard application process. Entry fees apply.
